We have been filing for Erate for quite a while now.

We had a vendor helping us for a good while.

Felt it was good time to explore new options and expand the scope.

Recently we began migrating to the CENIC network

The libraries that have not been migrated to CENIC network have not done so due to challenges dealing with the cost of getting decent bandwidth out to those areas such as Yosemite, Auberry, Shaver Lake, Wawona.

We feel that to get the entire service area up to par in terms of connectivity, we need to look beyond Erate to see how we can overcome these challenges, and this is why the RFP mentions a telecommunications consultant.

As such the work involved would not be limited to these branches 20 branches under erate, but would definitely be a starting point.

We hope we can establish a working relationship with a vendor who can continually identify funding strategies continually better our capacity including in places like Fresno, Tulare & Bakersfield.
